## NC State 600 Club 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Tournament Rules

1. This is a **Handicap Singles Tournament**, USBC Sanctioned and open to NC State 600 Club members only.
2. Eligibility requirements: Bowlers must be a female bowler and a current NCS-USBC and NC State 600 Club member in good standing.
3. Handicap will be 90% of 220 scratch.
4. Bowlers will use their highest USBC Sanctioned average from the 2017-18 league season of 21 games or more. If no yearbook average, bowlers shall use their current average of 21 games or more as of the competition date. If no average, entrants must bowl scratch figure of 220. **Bowler will be responsible for reporting and providing average verification before competition. Failure to do so will be grounds for disqualification.**
5. There will be two (2) average divisions. Division one will be those with an average of 174 and below. Division two will be those with an average of 175 and above. Entrants will bowl 4 games, moving one pair to the right after each game. Final prize list will be based off total pin fall + handicap.
6. We will offer a scratch option for an additional \$10. You must enter the handicap tournament to be able to bowl the scratch side. 6 games less the handicap will be used to determine prize winners. We will pay 1 in 4 for this option.
7. Prize monies will be returned 100% immediately following the completion of the tournament. Prize ratio will be 1:5. There will be a guarantee of \$400 for first in either division with 40 or more entries. In case of a tie, prize money will be combined and divided equally.
8. No practicing will be allowed on any tournament lanes on the day of competition.
9. Tournament director has the right to re-rate or reject any entry. If re-rating is necessary, the bowler will be notified before competition. If the re-rate is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
10. Proper attire is suggested. Shorts, skorts and skirts should be more than fingertip length. Name on the back of shirt is suggested, not required. No sleeveless tops, tank tops. Proper attire is at the discretion of the tournament director.
11. The use of substances such as powder, rosin, etc. on shoes to alter the normal conditions of the approach is strictly prohibited.
12. USBC rules 319a-2, 319d, and 319e are all waived for this tournament.
13. Any rule not covered within shall be governed by USBC Playing Rules. The NC State 600 Club Board of Directors will decide any questions not covered by the above rules.
14. Any protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be made verbally to the tournament director prior to completion of the tournament.

Note: The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the N.C. State 600 Club, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting there from, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the N.C. State 600 Club.
